Sustain, Grow, and Develop

To help sustain, grow, and develop the Mini Rugby program in Lloydminster we wanted to develop a continuous year round simple activity for fundraising that would be appropriate for our Mini members to do themselves. We also wanted to develop a fundraising activity that could be unique to the Lloydminster Mini Rugby program.

In an effort to help fundraise for the Mini Rugby we are asking all Mini members with the involvement of their parent or guardian to help with the collection of unwanted, unused, or unneeded Canadian Tire Money. Mini members are encouraged to collect Canadian Tire Money at home and from family or friends. Mini members wanting to make the extra effort are welcome to go door to door in their neighbourhood (with the supervision of a parent or guardian) asking for support of the Mini Rugby in the form of Canadian Tire Money, similar to bottle drives. If going door to door to help collect members should also make sure to wear a club shirt to help promote knowledge and recognition of Lloydminster Mini Rugby in the community.



Canadian Tire Money is something that has been available for many years now and is the equivalent of cash when used at any Canadian Tire location. Canadian Tire Money collected by the members can then be used to purchase items to support the development and growth of Mini's in the form of training and game gear. As the club grows gear will need to be added to allow for more children to participate and in time the replacement of worn out gear.

Any Canadian Tire money collected can be handed into the Mini members coach to direct to Todd Wilson during the season, and during the off season please contact Todd Wilson to arrange for dropping of Canadian Tire money collected.
